LITURGY OF ORDINATION

Election of the Candidates (*please be seated*)

A Deacon calls the candidates by name and the candidates announce their readiness to be ordained.

The Bishop inquires as to the worthiness of the candidates. Reverend Scott Kopp, Director of Seminarians, testifies that the candidates are worthy.

The Bishop declares the candidates chosen for priesthood and the entire assembly shows approval by responding: **Thanks be to God**.

Homily

Promise of the Elect

The candidates stand before the Bishop who questions their intentions to exercise the ministry of the word worthily and wisely; to celebrate the sacraments faithfully; and to pastorally care for those entrusted to them. The candidates then kneel before the Bishop promising him respect and obedience.

Litany of Supplication (please kneel)

Just before the order of priesthood is conferred, the Litany of the Saints is prayed on behalf of the candidates. The candidates lie prostrate on the floor in a gesture of humility, signifying their total dependence upon God.



Laying on of Hands (please stand)

In awesome silence, the Spirit of God is invoked upon the candidates as the Bishop lays his hands on their head. By this holy gesture, ancient in Scripture and Church tradition, the office of the priesthood is conferred. The priests present also lay hands upon the candidates to signify the oneness of priesthood which they all share.

Prayer of Ordination

To complete the ordination, the Bishop offers a solemn prayer which praises and thanks God for the unfailing gifts of ministry to the Church. At its conclusion, all respond: **Amen**.

Investiture (please be seated)

The new priests are vested with a chasuble and stole.



Anointing of Hands

The hands of the new priests are anointed to signify that like Christ, a priest is anointed to bless, consecrate, and sanctify.

Procession of Gifts

Handing Over of the Bread and Wine

The Bishop presents the paten of bread and the chalice of wine to the new priests.

Kiss of Peace

The new priests are welcomed into the order of presbyter by the priests assembled.
